The Village of Jacksonville met in special session with Mayor McNickle presiding and the meeting being called to order at 5:30P. Council members present were Eric Clift, Sam Smathers, Emily Swart and DJ Henry. Also present were Solicitor John Haseley and Fiscal Officer Heather Rockwell. Absent was Council member Butch Chapman.

Councilperson Clift made a motion to excuse Councilperson Chapman from the June 1, 2017 Special Council meeting. Seconded by Councilperson Smathers. All Council voted "yes". Motion carried.

Councilperson Smathers reported that an offer of employment for water clerk was extended to Amber Mayle for \$350.00 per month salary part time. Solicitor Haseley was directed to prepare a contract for Ms. Mayle. Councilperson Swart made a motion to pay Ms. Mayle her salary for work done in the month of May. Seconded by Councilperson Henry. All Council voted "yes". Motion carried.

Councilperson Swart made a motion to enter executive session to discuss personnel with regard to a vacant Council seat per ORC § 121.22(G)(1) and requested the presence of Solicitor Haseley, Fiscal Officer Rockwell and Mayor McNickle. Seconded by Councilperson Clift. All Council voted "yes". Motion carried. Meeting adjourned for executive session at 5:36P.




