Village of Jacksonville Special Council Meeting August 21, 2018 6:30 PM

The Village of Jacksonville met in special session with Mayor Sam Smathers presiding and the meeting being called to order at 6:30PM. Council members present were Emily Swart, Butch Chapman, Jay Chapman, Dave Moleski, and Rachel Clift.

Mayor Smathers opened the floor to Sheriff Smith. Smith addressed the members of the public present at the meeting and explained due process. Smith also explained that the Sheriff's Department enforces State Laws and that local police departments enforce local ordinances.
