

Motion carried. **RESOLUTION 2020-6: A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING REQUEST FOR AUDITOR'S CERTIFICATE AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.** Councilperson Butch Chapman made a motion to adopt Resolution 2020-6 as read. Seconded by Councilperson Swart. All Council voted "yes". Motion carried.

Seconded by Councilperson Slack. All Council voted "yes". Motion carried.
