

ORDINANCE NO. 12202016

ORDINANCE ADOPTING PUBLIC RECORDS POLICY AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the Village of Jacksonville needs to adopt a Public Records Policy;


WHEREAS, the Village Council has reviewed the Model Public Records Policy developed by the Ohio Attorney General, and wishes to adopt the same;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE VILLAGE OF JACKSONVILLE, ATHENS COUNTY, OHIO, AS FOLLOWS:

1. The Village of Jacksonville hereby adopts the Ohio Attorney General Model Public Records Policy as its own;
2. All deliberations resulting in the passage of this Ordinance were conducted in open meetings of Council, and that all deliberations of Council that resulted in such action were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code;
3. This Ordinance is being passed as an emergency measure on first reading, under suspension of the rules, to take effect immediately, pursuant to Ohio Rev. Code Sec. 731.30 for the reason that it is necessary for the immediate preservation of the health, safety and welfare of the residents of the Village of Jacksonville.
4. Publication of this Ordinance shall be made by posting a copy of the same within at least five (5) locations within the village.
5. This Ordinance shall become effective the earliest date provided by law.
