## A RESOLUTION DECLARING IT NECESSARY TO LEVY A TAX IN EXCESS OF THE TEN MILL LIMITATION

Revised Code, Section 5705.19, 5705.191, 5705.192, 5705.194, 5705.21, 5705.26

The Council of the Village of Jacksonville, Athens County, Ohio, met in regular session on the 26<sup>th</sup> day of May, 2022 at the office of Village Council with the following members present:

WHEREAS, the amount of taxes which may be raised within the ten (10) mill limitation (ORC § 5705.02), will be insufficient to provide an adequate amount for the necessary requirements of said Village of Jacksonville, Athens County, Ohio;	
RESOLVED, by the Council of the Village of Jacksonville, Athens County, Ohio, two-thirds of all members elected thereto concurring, that it is necessary to levy a tax in excess of the ten (10) mill limitation for the benefit of the Village of Jacksonville for the purpose of Current Operating Expenses pursuant to Ohio Revised Code § 5705.19(A) at a rate not exceeding six (6.00) mills for each one dollar (\$1.00) of valuation, which amounts to a maximum of no dollars and sixty cents (\$0.60) for each one hundred dollars (\$100.00) of valuation for a renewal of five (5) years commencing in 2023, first due in calendar year 2024.	
<b>RESOLVED</b> , that the question of levying additional taxes be submitted to the electors of said Village of Jacksonville at the General election to be held at the usual voting places within said Village of Jacksonville on the 8 <sup>th</sup> day of November, 2022; and be it further	
RESOLVED, that said levy be placed upon the tax list of succeeding the election, if a majority of the electors voting	ng thereon vote in favor thereof; and be it further
<b>RESOLVED</b> , that the Fiscal Officer of the said Village of Jacksonville, Athens County, Ohio, notify the Board of Elections to cause notice of election on the question of levying said tax to be given as required by law.
