## **RESOLUTION 2022-7**

## A RESOLUTION DECLARING IT NECESSARY TO LEVY A TAX IN EXCESS OF THE TEN MILL LIMITATION AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

Revised Code, Section 5705.19, 5705.191, 5705.192, 5705.194, 5705.21, 5705.26

The Council of the Village of Jacksonville, Athens County, Ohio, met in Regular session on the <u>315</u>t day of January 2022 at the office of Village Council with the following members present:

Councilperson Angela Strock moved the adoption of the following Resolution:
WHEREAS, the amount of taxes which may be raised within the ten (10) mill limitation (ORC § 5705.02), will be insufficient to provide an adequate amount for the necessary requirements of said Village of Jacksonville, Athens County, Ohio;
RESOLVED, by the Council of the Village of Jacksonville, Athens County, Ohio, two-thirds of all members elected thereto concurring, that it is necessary to levy a tax in excess of the ten (10) mill limitation for the benefit of the Village of Jacksonville for the purpose of Current Operating Expenses pursuant to Ohio Revised Code § 5705.19 (A) at a rate not exceeding five and three tenths (5.30) mills for each one dollar (\$1.00) of valuation, which amounts to a maximum of no dollars and fifty-three cents (\$0.53) for each one hundred dollars (\$100.00) of valuation for a renewal of five (5) years commencing in 2022, first due in calendar year 2023.
<b>RESOLVED</b> , that the question of levying additional taxes be submitted to the electors of said Village of Jacksonville at the Primary election to be held at the usual voting places within said Village of Jacksonville on the 3 <sup>th</sup> day of May, 2022; and be it further
<b>RESOLVED</b> , that said levy be placed upon the tax list of the current year after the February Settlement next succeeding the election, if a majority of the electors voting thereon vote in favor thereof; and be it further
<b>RESOLVED</b> , that the Fiscal Officer of the said Village of Jacksonville, Athens County, Ohio, notify the Board of Elections to cause notice of election on the question of levying said tax to be given as required by law; and be it further
<b>RESOLVED,</b> This Resolution is being passed as an emergency measure under suspension of the rules, to take effect immediately, pursuant to Ohio Revised Code Section 731.30 because it is necessary for the preservation of the health, safety and welfare of the citizens of Jacksonville to meet filing deadlines.
