

ORDINANCE 2017-06

AN ORDINANCE SETTING FORTH REGULATIONS FOR NEW WATER SERVICE CONNECTIONS AND METHOD OF DELIVERY FOR ANNUAL CONSUMER CONFIDENCE REPORTS AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, the Village of Jacksonville has adopted Ordinances pertaining to Water Service which require amendments to comply with State laws, including regulations for new water service connections and the method of delivery for annual consumer confidence reports;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF JACKSONVILLE, ATHENS COUNTY, OHIO AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: Any new water service connections to any Village water meter must be done so using new materials approved by the Environmental Protection Agency. The use of used and salvaged materials is strictly prohibited in the installation of new water service connections. Existing water lines from the new service connection to the residence are permitted to be used provided they do not consist of lead or brass. Any lead or brass lines or fitting must be replaced with new materials approved by the Environmental Protection Agency.

Section 2: Required annual reporting of Lead Programs and Consumer Confidence Reports will be performed using postcards mailed to all water customers of the Village of Jacksonville. Postcards will include a URL that will be a direct link to the report online and will indicate how to obtain a printed copy of the report.

Section 3: It is found and determined that all formal actions of Council concerning and relating to the passage of this Ordinance were conducted in open meetings of Council, and that all deliberations of Council that resulted in formal action were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements including Ohio Revised Code Section 121.22; and


Section 4: This Ordinance is being passed as an emergency measure under suspension of rules, to take effect immediately, pursuant to Ohio Revised Code Section 731.30 to preserve the public health, safety and welfare of the residents of the Village of Jacksonville, Ohio; and

Section 5: All previous Ordinances shall remain in full effect except for sections in direct contradiction with Sections 1 and 2 above; and

Section 6: Publication of this Ordinance shall be made by posting a copy of the same in at least five (5) locations within the Village of Jacksonville; and


Section 7: This Ordinance shall become effective at the earliest date allowed by law.
