

ORDINANCE NO. 2018-01

Ordinance Imposing a Boil Order for Jacksonville Water Department Customers Residing on Red Dog Road, Certain Residences on High Street and Certain Residences on Carter Road.

WHEREAS, the Jacksonville Village Council recognizes that the water pressure is below EPA standards at residences on the above-named roads.

WHEREAS, the Village will notify residents at each home located on these roads which have insufficient water pressure of this boil order by certified letter.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED THAT, UNTIL FURTHER NOTICE, THE VILLAGE OF JACKSONVILLE IMPOSES A PERMANENT BOIL ORDER FOR WATER CUSTOMERS ON RED DOG ROAD, CERTAIN RESIDENCES ON HIGH STREET AND CERTAIN RESIDENCES ON CARTER ROAD.

Duly enacted as an emergency measure under suspension of the rules this 17TH day of January, 2018.
