AUTHORIZING LEGISLATION

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR OF THE VILLAGE OF JACKSONVILLE TO PREPARE AND SUBMIT AN APPLICATION TO PARTICIPATE IN THE OHIO PUBLIC WORKS COMMISSION STATE CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT AND / OR LOCAL TRANSPORTATION IMPROVEMENT PROGRAM(S) AND TO EXECUTE CONTRACTS AS REQUIRED AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, the State Capital Improvement Program and the Local Transportation Improvement Program both provide financial assistance to political subdivisions for capital improvements to public infrastructure, and

WHEREAS, the Village of Jacksonville is planning to make capital improvements to the 2019 Water System Improvements, and

WHEREAS, the infrastructure improvement herein above described is considered to be a priority need for the community and is a qualified project under the OPWC programs,

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Village of Jacksonville:

Section 1: The Mayor is hereby authorized to apply to the OPWC for funds as described above.

Section 2: The Mayor is authorized to enter into any agreements as may be necessary and appropriate for obtaining this financial assistance.

Section 3: This Resolution is being passed as an emergency measure under suspension of the rules, to take effect immediately, pursuant to Ohio Revised Code Section 731.30 because it is necessary for the preservation of the health, safety and welfare of the citizens of Jacksonville.
