

RESOLUTION NO. 2018 -20

RESOLUTION REQUESTING FROM THE COUNTY AUDITOR A CERTIFICATE OF ESTIMATED PROPERTY TAX MILLAGE RATE, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, Jacksonville residents are increasingly concerned about incidents of crime occurring in the Village and which threaten the health and safety of Village residents;

WHEREAS, the Village Safety Committee has heard from Jacksonville residents who believe a local police presence could help improve Village safety;

WHEREAS, the Village Safety Committee has determined that the most cost-effective means of establishing a Village police presence would be contracting with a neighboring community;


WHEREAS, the Village of Glouster has provided an estimate that could allow the Village of Jacksonville to contract with Glouster for a full-time officer for approximately \$60,828 per year; and


WHEREAS, Jacksonville Village Council wishes to receive an estimate from the Athens County Auditor of the millage rate necessary to pay for a \$65,000 annual expense through an Additional Levy for police services under ORC 5705.19 to be placed on the ballot in the general election on November ~~X~~, 2019 and to commence in Calendar Year 2020 for Tax Year 2019. 5

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT THE VILLAGE OF JACKSONVILLE HEREBY REQUESTS THE ATHENS COUNTY AUDITOR TO PROVIDE A CERTIFICATE OF ESTIMATED PROPERTY TAX MILLAGE RATE TO SUPPORT A NEW EXPENDITURE OF \$65,000.
