WHEREAS, the amount of taxes which may be raised within the ten-mill limitation will be insufficient to provide an adequate amount for the necessary requirements of the said Village of Jacksonville, Athens County; therefore be it

RESOLVED, by the Council, Athens County, two-thirds of all members elected thereto concurring, that it is necessary to levy a tax in excess of the ten mill limitation for the benefit of the Village of Jacksonville for the purpose of General Fund - Current Operating Expenses of the Village of Jacksonville pursuant to section 5705.19(A) Ohio Revised Code
